## Registration

- *MYZOU*: computer-based registration: [myzou.missouri.edu](http://myzou.missouri.edu)
- Meet with your adviser as soon as possible to decide on classes
- Know reference numbers for all of your classes (check myzou)
- *Consent numbers* are often needed for graduate classes outside of (and even in) your department. Department administrative assistants have these consent numbers. You may need to first get permission from the course instructor (doable via e-mail), then get the consent number from the administrative assistant.
- *Overrides* are sometimes needed if the class you are trying to register for is full. Check with the course instructor first, then get the override number from the administrative assistant.
