When might consultation be requested?

- Prior to making decision about curriculum selection for 1 hour at no cost
- After initial training when additional assistance is requested

Consultation	Model	Cost
Preschool/district may request time to chat regarding curriculum selection and exploration.	On-line chat or phone call	No fee for 1 hour
Preschool/district may request time to chat online or phone regarding questions following training pertaining to key components, instructional essentials, or any information related to the curriculum and its implementation. [A date, time and length of call will be established for the consultant to be available for conversation, problem-solving, responses to preschool queries.]	On-line chat (Skype or other on-line system) or phone	\$ 100 Per hour
ELLC consultant will meet with administrators/teachers/paras/specialists at the school district site when requested. [Prior to meeting, an agenda will be developed. District will share questions and topics for discussion. Observation in classrooms will be included as part of the consultation.]	On-site at program	\$1,000 Per day (6 hrs.) plus travel expenses
Preschool/district will request a topic for a 3-hour workshop that they wish to learn more about. Additionally, half of the day will be available for the consultant to observe in the classroom for fidelity, for room set-up, for observing any of the four key components.	½ day workshop + ½ day observation on-site	\$1,200 Per day (6 hrs.) plus travel expenses
Side by side coaching, modeling, demonstrations, planning and goal setting.	On-site at program	\$1,000 Per day (6 hrs.) plus travel expenses
