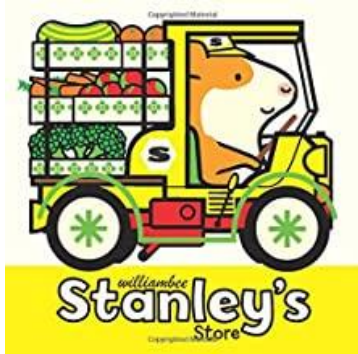

Stanley's Store describes a busy day at Stanley's store. Stanley unloads produce from his truck and uses his forklift to stock the store. Myrtle, Shamus, and Little Woo shop for groceries among Stanley's beautiful displays of vegetables, fruits, bread, and cheeses of different shapes. The rich illustrations in this book provide many options for discussions of food groups, shapes, colors, and shopping for groceries. The book sets the stage for the creation of a grocery store in the Dramatic Play Center and the concepts are supported in ELLC Circle Time activities. Opportunities for focusing on vocabulary related to the unit theme and key concept abound in the story and the illustrations in this book.
